## DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

### July 2016

#### Newly Hired Officers

The department sends newly hired officers to the Ohio State Highway Patrol's Basic Academy or the Columbus Police Academy. On Friday July 8, 2016, Officer Lukas Burr graduated from the Columbus Police Academy. He successfully completed a 27 week training program at the academy. Academy staff praised Officer Burr during his academy training and he is excelling in his field training program. Officer Burr has a Bachelors Degree from the Olivet Nazarene University in Criminal Justice, and was a police officer in Kentucky before being hired by New Albany.

Two additional police officer cadets, Chad Bauman and Ian McCord, are currently in the Columbus Police Academy and are anticipated to graduate at the end of the year. A third cadet, Brandon Stokes, will be attending the Ohio Highway Patrol's Basic Police Academy beginning on August 15<sup>th</sup>. Brandon will graduate at the end of the year. Greg Thomas was also hired as a police officer during the recent hiring process. Greg came to the department from the Ohio Highway Patrol and will not need to attend an additional police academy. He will begin the field training program immediately.

#### Fourth of July Event

This year's 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade and fireworks were well attended with no significant problems or arrests.

Officers provide launch site security, event security and directed traffic for the run, parade and fireworks display.

#### Rolling Drug Lab

On July 13, Officer Joel Strahler and Officer Lucas Burr witnessed a Honda driving outside of the marked lanes on Dublin Granville Rd. The driver was stopped for marked lanes violation and on the suspicion of driving while intoxicated. After failing a field sobriety test the driver was placed under arrest for OVI.

Officers searched the driver and found 94 (2mg) Xanax tablets and small amount of marijuana in a coat pocket. During an inventory of the vehicle, officers found drug paraphilia and what appeared to be drug manufacturing equipment, supplies and chemicals in the trunk of the vehicle. The Columbus Police Meth Lab Response Team was called to assist the officers. The response team verified that what was in the trunk is used in the manufacturing of illegal drugs. The driver is facing felony drug charges.

### **July 2016**

#### **Pokemon Go**

The police department has been receiving calls related to the new Pokemon Go game. The calls are generally about people or groups of people gathering in places and times that are unusual. Officers have been dispatched to churches, businesses, parks, as well as neighborhoods to investigate suspicious people and vehicles. The calls have resulted in one drug arrest and has made it somewhat difficult for officers to distinguish between game activities and criminal activity.

### **July 2016**

#### **Robbery**

Detective Deckop gathered evidence and presented a grand jury packet to Warren County where the suspect will be prosecuted for all three bank robberies.
