Road Closings and Traffic Changes Necessary to Create Rose Run Park

In late 2019, Rose Run Park, our village green in the center of New Albany, will open, connecting people to each other, our civic amenities and nature. We have worked carefully to develop an efficient timeline and process that minimizes disruption and ensures safety throughout the construction phase. Consequently, additional road closures will occur October 1, 2018 while the traffic pattern changes to the McCoy Center Loop remain in effect.

Dublin-Granville Road Closed between Fodor and McCoy Center Loop

Dublin-Granville Road, between Fodor Road and the McCoy Center Loop, will close on October 1, 2018. Drivers can access McCoy Center Loop by turning on Dublin-Granville Road from Main Street. The leisure trail on the north side of Dublin-Granville Road along the school campus will also close. When Dublin-Granville Road construction is complete, traffic lanes will be narrowed and the streetscape will feature crosswalks, creating a safer environment for children around the school campus. A protected bike lane and pedestrian sidewalk will be added.

Village Hall Road Closed between Market and Main Streets

On October 1, 2018, Village Hall Road will close beyond the first entrance to the Heit Center parking lot from Main Street. This road closure will allow us to create amenities on the south side of Rose Run Park, including the new Rose Run Bridge, Promenade and Library Garden as well as upgrades to the parking lot adjacent to Village Hall Road. Drivers will still have access to the Heit Center parking lot and post office. The pedestrian bridge from the Heit Center to the school campus will remain open for student drop off and pickup daily.
