Road Closings and Traffic Changes Necessary to Create Rose Run Park

Construction of Rose Run Park will require road closings and traffic changes to protect the safety of our school children and allow the project to proceed efficiently. We apologize if these changes cause inconveniences. Be assured that the city has worked closely with the New Albany-Plain Local Schools and Messer Construction to provide a plan that causes the least amount of disruption. Thank you for your patience.

August 16 – Access to NAPLS from McCoy Center Loop Changed

Access to the middle, intermediate and primary schools from the McCoy Center Loop on Dublin-Granville Road will remain open, but the traffic pattern will change. Drivers will enter and exit from the entrance closest to the McCoy Center. The NAPLS middle school loop on Dublin-Granville Road will also close. New Albany is providing enhanced security around the campus for added safety and encourage drivers to use other drop off points. Emergency services will have access to all portions of the campus, even areas closed to normal traffic, throughout construction.

October 1 – Dublin-Granville Road Closed between Fodor and McCoy Center Loop

Dublin-Granville Road, between Fodor Road and the McCoy Center Loop, closes October 1. Drivers can access McCoy Center Loop by turning on Dublin-Granville Road from Main Street. The leisure trail on the north side of Dublin-Granville Road along the school campus will also close. When all Dublin-Granville Road construction is complete the traffic lanes will be narrowed, and the streetscape will feature brick-paved crosswalks, a protected bike lane and pedestrian sidewalk.

October 1 – Village Hall Road Closed between Market and Main Streets

Village Hall Road will be permanently closed beyond the first entrance to the Heit Center parking lot from Main Street. Drivers will still have access to the Heit Center parking lot and post office. The pedestrian bridge from the Heit Center to the school campus will remain open. The road closure will allow us to construct amenities on the southside of Rose Run Park, including the Library Gardens as well as upgrades to the parking lot adjacent to Village Hall Road.
