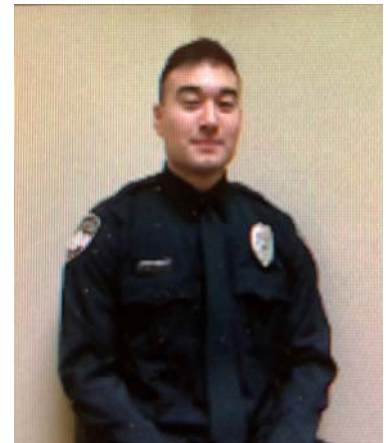

Amigo and the training was provided by Shallow Creek Kennels in Pennsylvania. Amigo is a drug detection and tracking canine.
