Officer Rehnert's training began in December but Amigo's training began weeks prior to being teamed up with Officer Rehnert. Amigo is a year and half old German Short Haired Pointer from Holland. Amigo and the training was provided by Shallow Creek Kennels in Pennsylvania. Amigo is a drug detection and tracking canine. In the short time he has been with the department he has proved his abilities with several successful drug detection deployments.
