We Are Ahead of Schedule to Reopen Dublin-Granville Road

We are pleased to report that Dublin-Granville Road, between Fodor Road and Main Street, will reopen in mid-September, more than three months ahead of schedule. When the road reopens it will feature narrower lanes to reduce speeds in the school campus area. Brick-paved crosswalks will provide safe travel for school children and pedestrians. The first half mile of the new Velo Loop will offer a protected bike lane. Walking trails will extend to the city's 45+ mile trail system. A terraced limestone and grass wall along the school campus will add space for large events.

We greatly appreciate your patience during the road closing as part of the development of our new Rose Run Park. Completing the project will require additional work this summer including:

- Dublin-Granville Road, from Fodor Road to just west of Main Street, closes June 3. Drivers will have access to local businesses along the road.
- The McCoy Center/Middle School Parking Lot closes June 3 and reopens at the beginning of the school year. Please see map below for McCoy Center temporary and handicap parking as well as alternative parking locations for the middle school.
- Construction at the Fodor Road/Dublin-Granville Road and Dublin-Granville Road/Main Street intersections and along High Street near the primary school/annex parking lot takes place this summer. Traffic will be maintained with flaggers.
- Work related to Rose Run Park will continue in the Heit Center parking lot during the summer.
- Access to the McCoy Center/Middle School parking lot from Dublin-Granville Road for student drop off and pick up reopens at the beginning of the school year.
- Access to the middle/high school cafeteria loop for express drop off and pick up reopens in mid-September.
- The walking trails on the north side of Dublin-Granville Road, along the school campus, reopen in mid-September.
