



RESOLUTION R-12-2023

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE, BID, AWARD AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MARKET STREET EXTENSION PROJECT

WHEREAS, Council desires to make infrastructure improvements that enhance the movement of traffic and reduce traffic congestion throughout the city; and

WHEREAS, the Market Street extension project was thoroughly evaluated and modeled in conjunction with the 2020 strategic plan update and is included as a recommended roadway improvement project to help mitigate traffic congestion in the Village Center; and

WHEREAS the engineer's estimate for the projects is \$9.1M; and

WHEREAS, the completion of this infrastructure improvement project will provide for enhanced vehicular and pedestrian access and safety in the Village Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of New Albany, Counties of Franklin and Licking, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. The city manager is hereby authorized and directed to advertise, bid, award and execute all contractual documents necessary to accomplish the construction of the Market Street extension project.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of council, and that all deliberations of the council and or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3. Pursuant to Article 6.07(A) of the New Albany Charter, this resolution shall take effect upon adoption.



RESOLUTION R-13-2023

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION R-15-2022 TO INCLUDE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND LEISURE TRAIL FACILITIES AT A LOCATION ADJACENT TO THE HISTORIC EALY HOUSE AND EALY SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, Council desires to make infrastructure improvements that enhance pedestrian connectivity throughout the Village Center; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-15-2022 includes the construction of 2 pedestrian bridges and trail facilities located at the northwest and southwest corners of Dublin-Granville Road and Harlem Road (north); and

WHEREAS, this resolution expands the scope of R-15-2022 to include the construction of a pedestrian bridge and trail facilities generally located between the Ealy House and the Ealy subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the engineer's estimate for additional bridge and trail facilities is \$220,000; and

WHEREAS, the completion of this infrastructure improvement project will provide for enhanced pedestrian access and safety in the Village Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of New Albany, Counties of Franklin and Licking, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. The city manager is hereby authorized and directed to advertise, bid, award and execute all contractual documents necessary to accomplish the construction of the Market Street extension project.


