Distracted Driving Presentation

Chief Jones attended a local businesses' luncheon to discuss distracted driving with their staff. Chief Jones spoke with employees about the dangers of distracted driving, related statistics and utilized the department's new SIDNE distracted driving goggles. Employees wore the goggles while they were asked to perform tasks. The intermittent blinding effect of the goggles simulate the impact of texting while driving.

Leadership New Albany

The New Albany Police Department hosted the Leadership New Albany development program as part of the program's local government session. The group was given a tour of the station and they had the opportunity to meet with our officers and dispatchers.

School Safety Drills

Officer Southers assisted with a "Stay Put" school safety drill conducted at the high school. A "Stay Put" is put into place by the administration when a situation arises that is not life threatening, but requires the hallways to be kept clear for a period of time.



For the month of February, Amigo conducted 28 detection deployments and one patrol deployment. He had 17 indications for drug paraphernalia, including marijuana, methamphetamine and heroin. Over the course of the month, Amigo's work resulted in over 25 items seized and three arrests.

Led by Sharon Saia, MSW, LISW-S, Director, Employee Assistance Program at The Ohio State University and a certified EMDR therapist, the training is based on research on the use of eye movements with acute stress.</p> |
