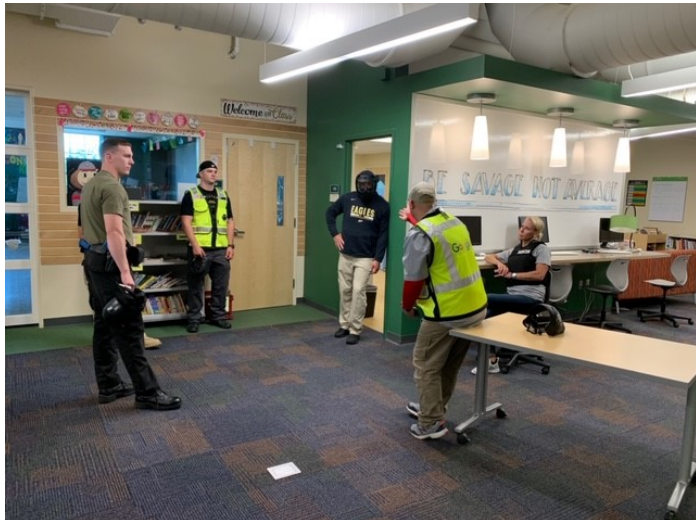
## July 2020

#### STOPPED Program

The New Albany Police Department participates in the Franklin County STOPPED (Sheriff's Telling Our Parents & Promoting Educated Drivers) program. This program was originally developed by the Onondaga County Sheriff's Department in New York and was designed to reduce the number of young drivers involved in automobile accidents. Our department runs a monthly report that is sent to the STOPPED program and they send notifications to parents informing them of a traffic stop involving their child.

The New Albany Police Department received a voicemail from a parent who had received a letter as a result of this program:

*"I just wanted to call and let you guys know how much we appreciated getting one of those STOPPED letters communicating to us that our son had been pulled over on his way to his place of employment. As a young driver, we tell him always not to speed, speed kills etc. . . . He said he was late to work, but we just wanted to let you know how much we appreciated getting one of those letters because he had failed to let us know... Thanks again for the letter and we appreciate the work you do and these kinds of programs that help us guide them in the right way. Thank you!"*

### K9 Amigo Deployment Summary

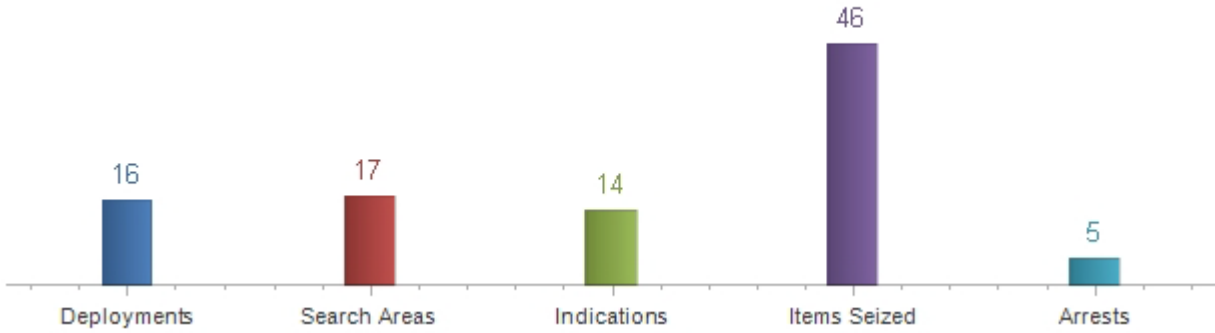
For the month of July, Amigo conducted 16 detection deployments. He had 14 indications and seized over 45 items. As a result of their work, there were 5 arrests made.

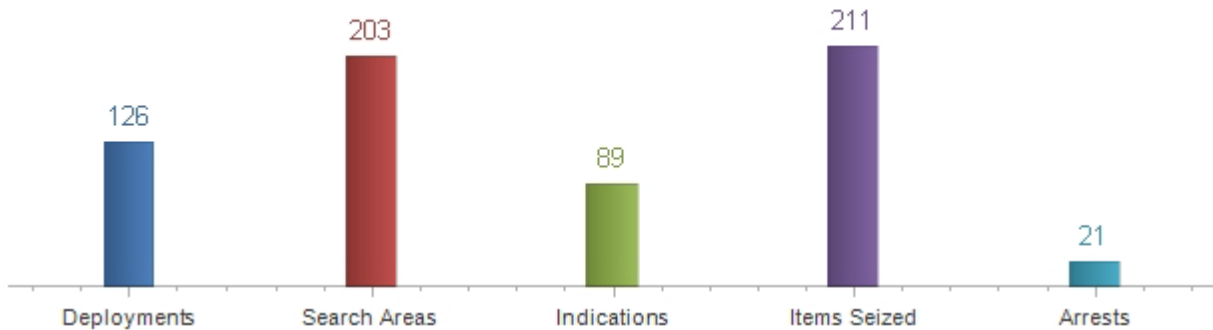
