### September 2020

#### Detective Bureau

## DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

### September 2020

#### Leadership New Albany

Sergeant Nemeth graduated from the New Albany Chamber's 2020 Leadership New Albany Class on September 16th. Although the class was primarily virtual due to COVID-19, members had the opportunity to connect with others in the community. The eight month program allowed participants to learn and gain a better understanding of the New Albany business, economic, civic and government landscape.



#### Property Room Destruction

The department must dispose of unneeded and/or unclaimed property in the property room annually to make room for property that is to be held as evidence or safe keeping. The disposal of property must be approved by a judge and the disposal process is regulated to make sure the property is disposed of properly. Recently, thousands of items were disposed of as prescribed by a judge. The process took nearly a week to complete and several officers assisted with the process.

## DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

### September 2020

#### Bicycle Education Classes

Officer Southers and Officer Kelly assisted the Marburn Academy with the bicycle education block of their physical education program. The officers participated in classes for a little over a week. The officers rode with the students who were mainly elementary age and assisted the class teacher with improving the students' safety and riding skills. All of the early instruction for the classes took place on the campus of Marburn Academy but once the students' skills had improved, the officers took the students and their teacher for a group bike ride around the Windsor subdivision.



#### School Safety Drills

School Resource Officer Southers and DARE Officer Kelly conducted the annual Theoretical School Safety Drills for each of the five schools in the New Albany Plain Local School District. The Theoretical Drill would normally be a hands on scenario based drill conducted with staff only, but due to restrictions on social distancing, the drill had to be conducted virtually. The officers set up the five virtual meetings with the schools to provide the presentation that reviewed the principles of ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate), gave the staff members theoretical scenarios, and encouraged staff involvement through question and answer periods.

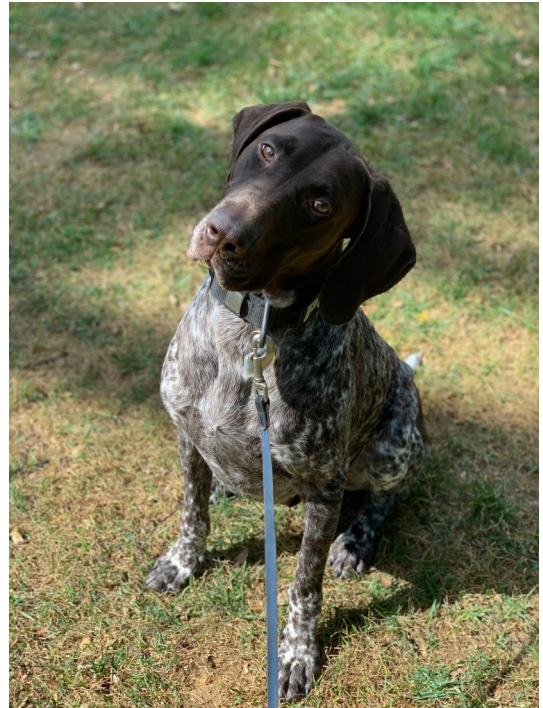

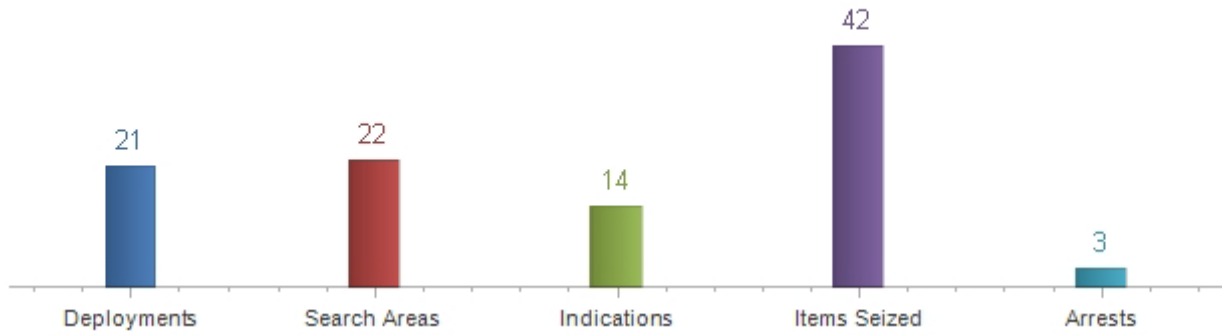
### K9 Amigo Deployment Summary

During the month of September, Amigo and his handler conducted 21 detection deployments. He had 14 indications and seized over 40 items. As a result of their work, there were three arrests made.



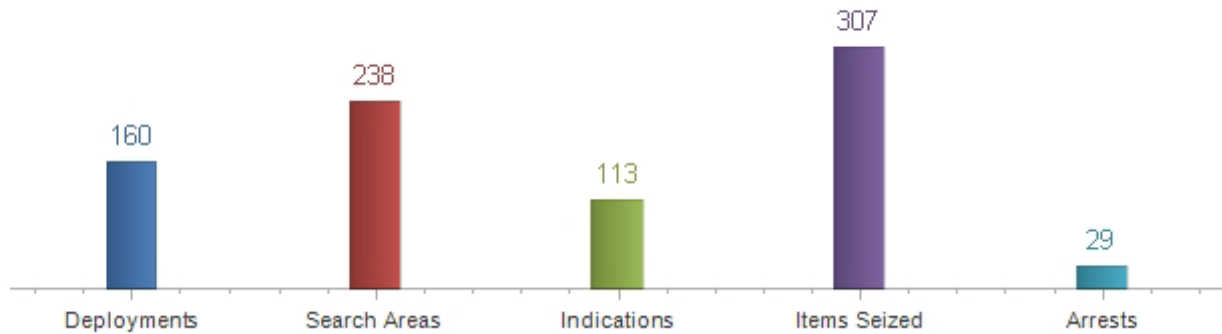
