#### Award


Officer Nate Ferguson received a commendation from Gahanna Police Chief, Jeff Spence for deploying spike strips to end a pursuit of a breaking and entering suspect. After receiving a call for assistance from the Gahanna Police Department, Officer Ferguson was able to deploy spike strips in the path of the vehicle that Gahanna Police were chasing. The suspect ran over the spikes, causing the front tires to deflate. The suspect's vehicle quickly became disabled and the suspect fled on foot. The suspect was apprehended a short time later.

### DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS March 2021

#### **Department In-Service Training**

The police department implemented quarterly in-service training to specifically cover many core competency skills within a training schedule that is more predictable and consistent. The in-service training in March focused on defensive tactics, de-escalation and CPR/First Aid refresher.






Officer Warner completed 40 hours of basic school resource officer training. Officer Warner was selected to teach New Albany's D.A.R.E program at the beginning of 2021 when the position was vacated by Officer Kelly. Officer Warner will attend the D.A.R.E. instructor course later in the year and will begin teaching D.A.R.E. this fall.

The department's drone pilots attended a multi-jurisdictional drone training event hosted by the Westerville Division of Police. This is the first training put together of its kind in the Central Ohio area and it will continue bi-monthly for the remainder of 2021. As part of their training, they conducted several mock scenarios intended to improve interoperability and the proficiency of all the agencies in attendance.


#### K9 Amigo Deployment Summary

Officer Rehnert and K9 Amigo were called to assist the Drug Enforcement Administration and the Post Master General at the Columbus' main post office with a search. Amigo alerted to several pounds of meth being shipped through the mail. The team was also able to help establish probable cause to obtain a warrant for an additional package containing several pressed fentanyl pills. Great work, Officer Rehnert and K9 Amigo!

During the month of March, Amigo and his handler conducted 21 detection deployments. He had 16 indications and seized over 50 items. As a result of their work, there were four arrests made.


