

## INVITATION TO BID

Sealed proposals for the **2021 CITY OF NEW ALBANY STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT 611-21** will be received by the City Manager of the City of New Albany, Ohio at Village Hall, 99 W. Main Street, New Albany, Ohio until 11:00 A.M., local time on:

**June 11, 2021**

and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud. All bids will be considered valid until 60 days after the opening date, although not accepted or rejected.

The work for which proposals are invited consists of the furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment required for the **2021 CITY OF NEW ALBANY STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**. These improvements will include, but not limited to, Pavement Planing, Asphalt Overlay, Crack Sealing, Pavement Repairs, Pavement Markings, Curb Replacement, ADA Curb Ramp Replacement, Sidewalk Removal/Replacement and Leisure Trail Removal/Replacement.

The **2021 CITY OF NEW ALBANY STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT** construction cost estimates are as follows:

<b>Base Bid</b>	<b>\$900,000 (Street Repaving, ADA Ramps, Crack Sealing, Striping, etc.)</b>
<b>Alternate 1</b>	<b>\$140,000 (Hampsted Village Sidewalk Replacement)</b>
<b>Alternate 2</b>	<b>\$340,000 (Leisure Trail Replacement)</b>
<b>Alternate 3</b>	<b>\$25,000 (6" Underdrain Installation)</b>
<b>Alternate 4</b>	<b>\$35,000 (Forest Dr. Traffic Improvements)</b>
<b>Alternate 5</b>	<b>\$45,000 (Miracle Field On-Street Parking)</b>

**A Pre-Bid meeting will be held on, June 7, 2021 at 9:00am, at the New Albany Public Service Facility, 7800 Bevelhymer Road, New Albany, Ohio to discuss any questions that the bidding contractors may have.**

Copies of the Contract Documents and Specifications are on file at the New Albany Public Service Department, 7800 Bevelhymer Road, New Albany, Ohio, where they are available for inspection by prospective bidders. All proposals shall be made on standard bidding blanks furnished by the City of New Albany. The envelope containing the proposal shall be endorsed with pertinent description of the work bid upon. Contract Documents and Specifications may be obtained from the above office upon payment of **\$25.00** per set, which amount will not be refunded. **Checks only, payable to City of New Albany.**

Each bid shall be signed by a corporate officer of the bidder, if bidder is a corporation, and shall contain the full name and address of each person or company interested in the same and shall be accompanied by a Proposal Bond in the amount of the bid, or by a certified check, cashier's check or irrevocable letter of credit for ten percent (10%) of the bid, made

payable to the City of New Albany conditioned that if the bid is accepted a Contract will be entered into within 10 days after notice of acceptance. A Contract Bond of One Hundred (100%) of the amount of the Contract with a satisfactory surety company, conditioned according to the law, will be required for the faithful performance of the Contract.

Each bidder must insure that all employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

Bidders are required to submit bids using current prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Franklin County and the City of New Albany, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division.

The address of the bidder shall be given with the signature of the bid.

The Bidder is required to fill out and where required execute each of the documents outlined in the Information for Bidders section.

The contract and notice to proceed shall be signed on or about June 18, 2021, and the work shall commence immediately thereafter. **All work for the 2021 CITY of NEW ALBANY STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT shall be completed by October 15, 2021.** The contractor will be required to submit a schedule of construction for approval by the City of New Albany prior to commencing construction.

The Bidder will be required to state in full detail, with the proposal, project experience in this class of work; bids from contractors inexperienced in this particular class of work will not be considered.

The Contractor shall, to the extent possible, use, and shall cause all of his subcontractors to use, Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in connection with the Project.

City of New Albany, Franklin County, Ohio, reserves the right to reject any or all bids, including all bids, which, in the opinion of the City Engineer, show evidence of unbalancing prices, and also to waive technical defects as the interest of City of New Albany may require.
