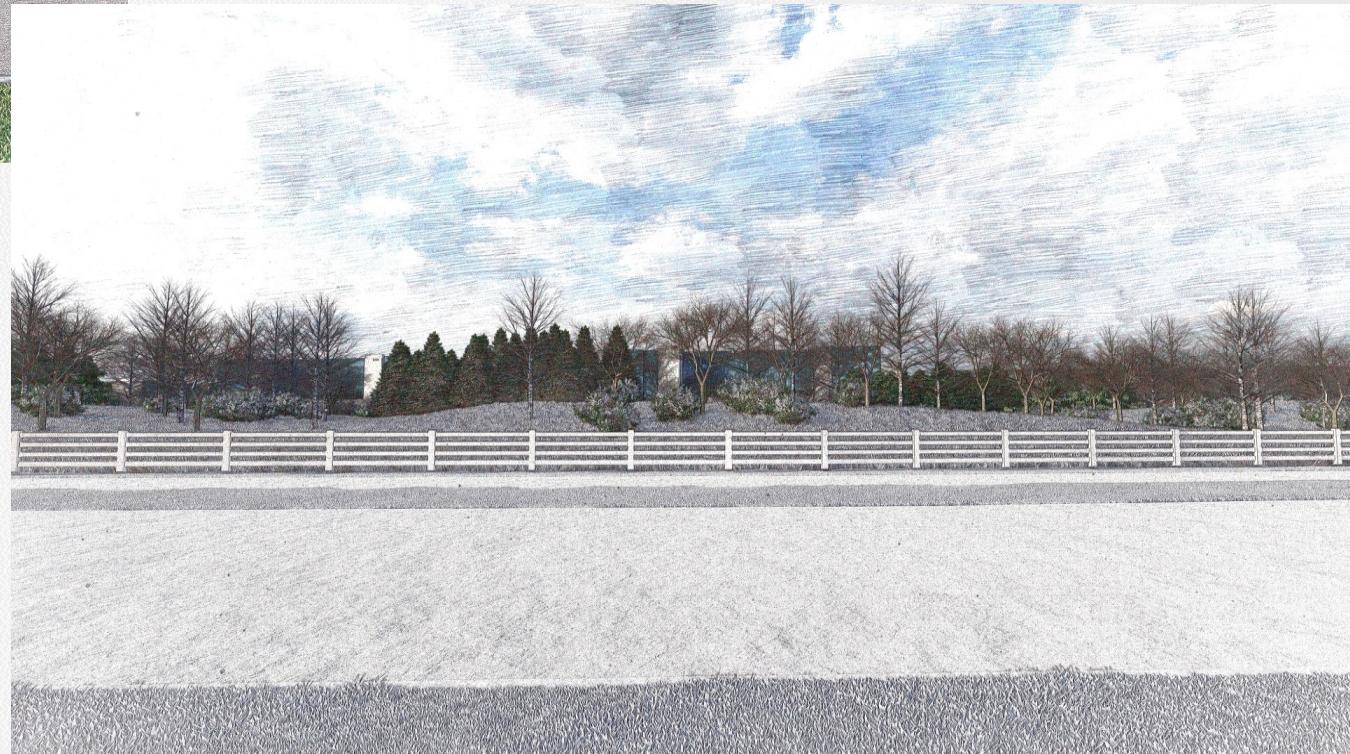
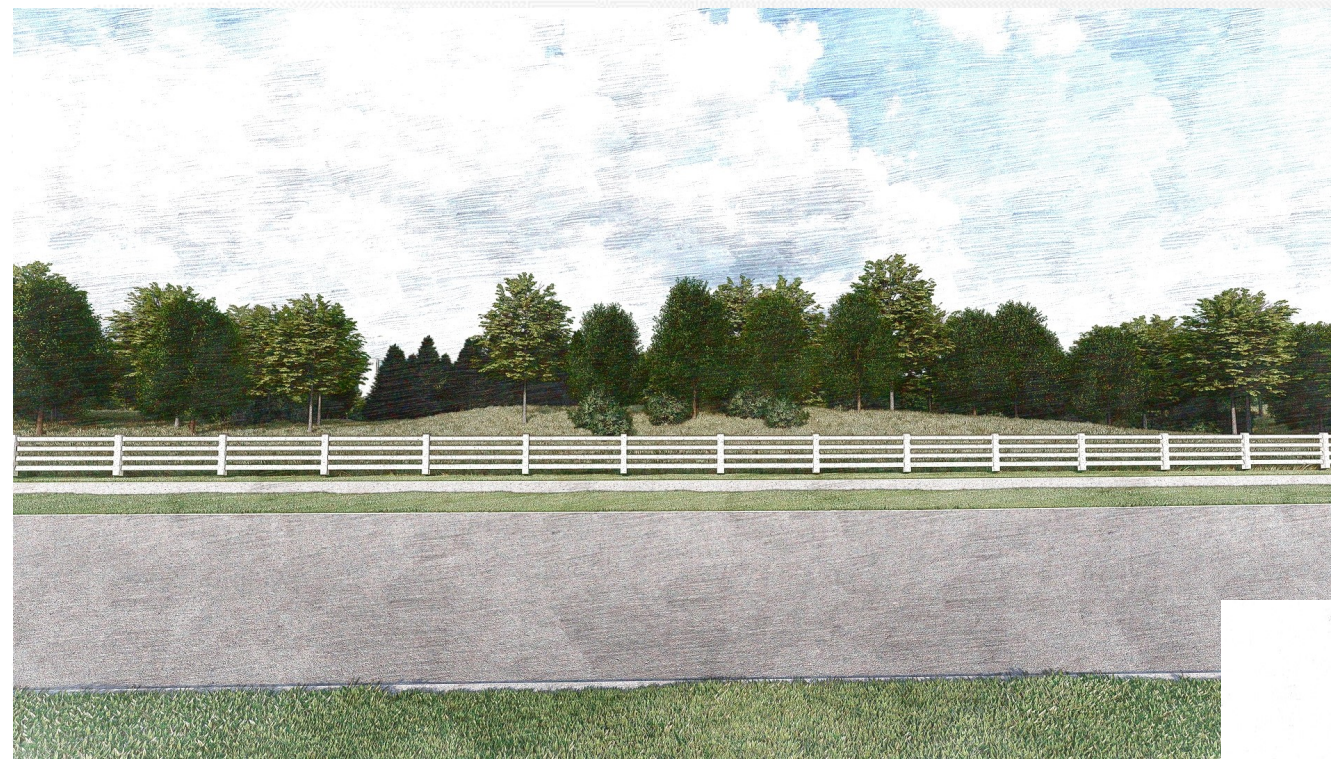


# Intel Ohio: Phase One Development



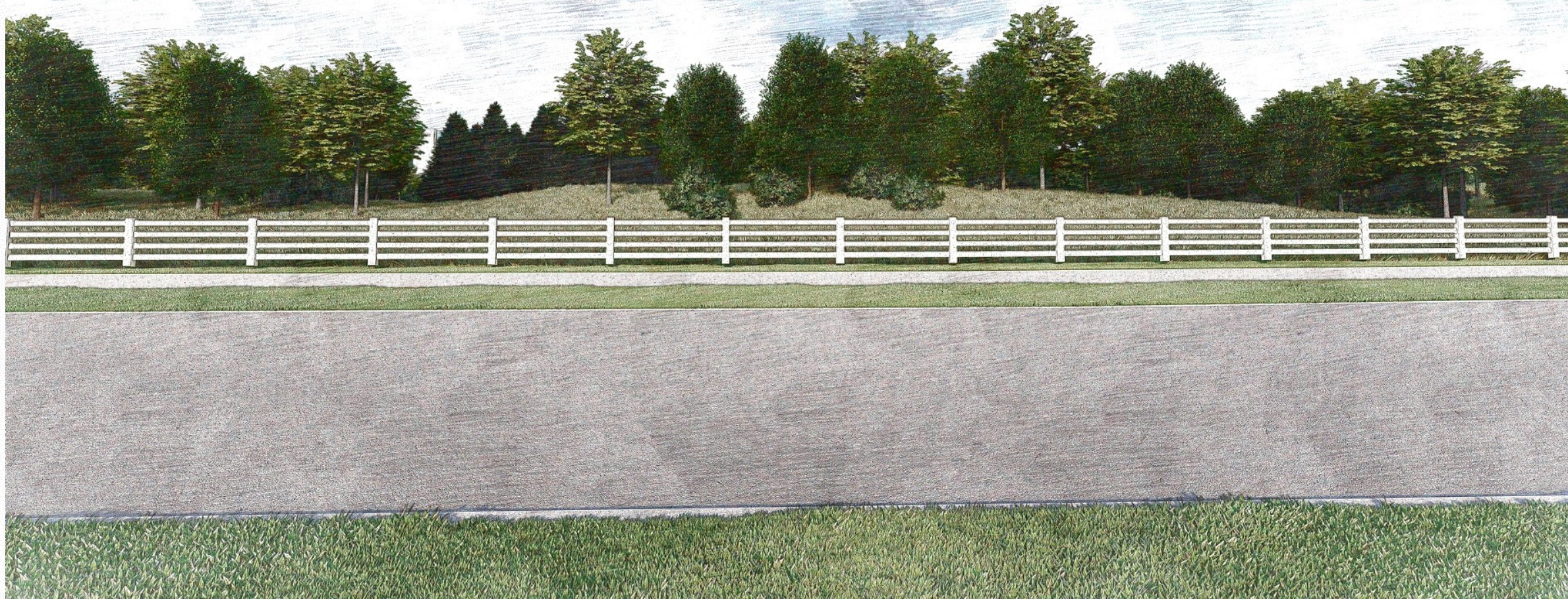


Enhanced landscaping and screening: View from Green Chapel Road.

St. Phase 1.



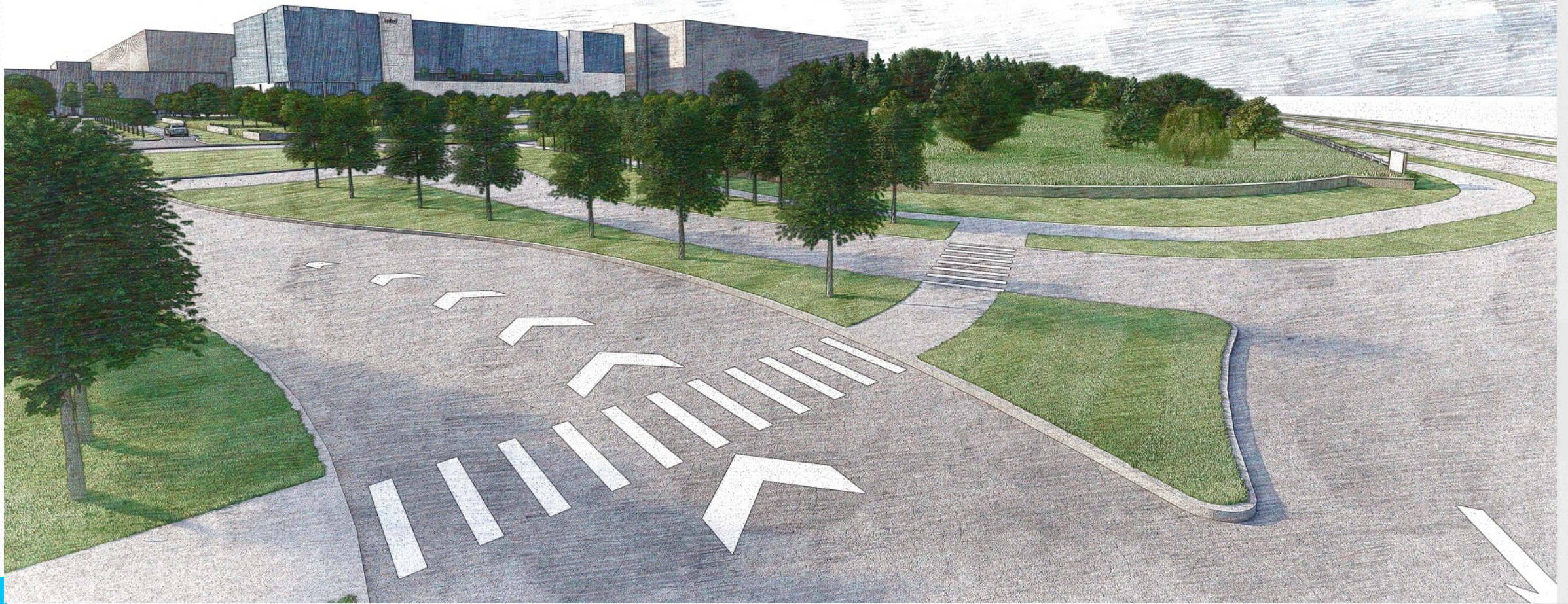


View of the Main site

- Monthly on-site meetings to ensure collaboration and clear communication of changes





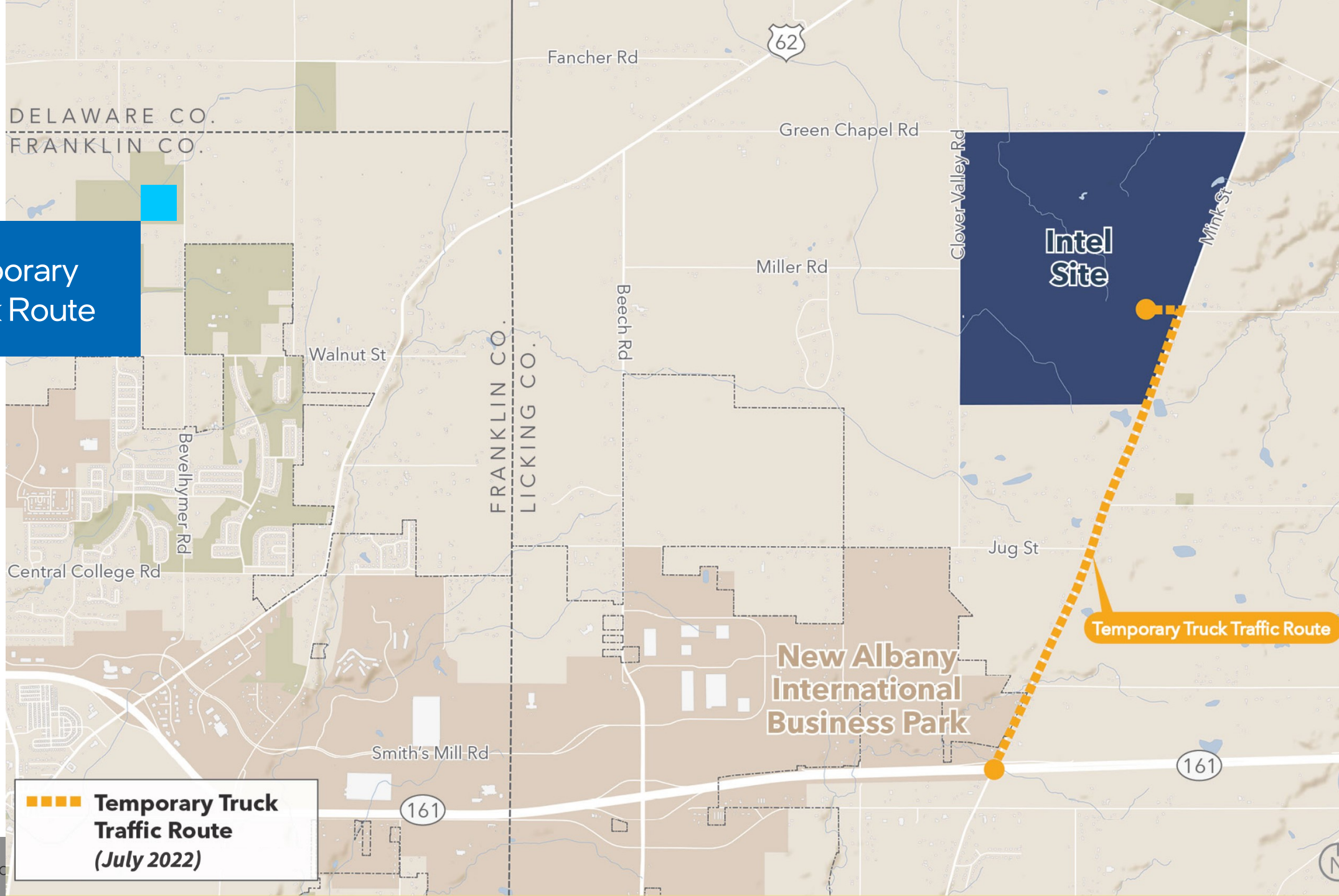
# Construction Timeline

- July 1: Early site work start
- Early start time, 6 days a week (Monday through Saturday)
- Approximately three years of construction
- Operations coming on-line in 2025

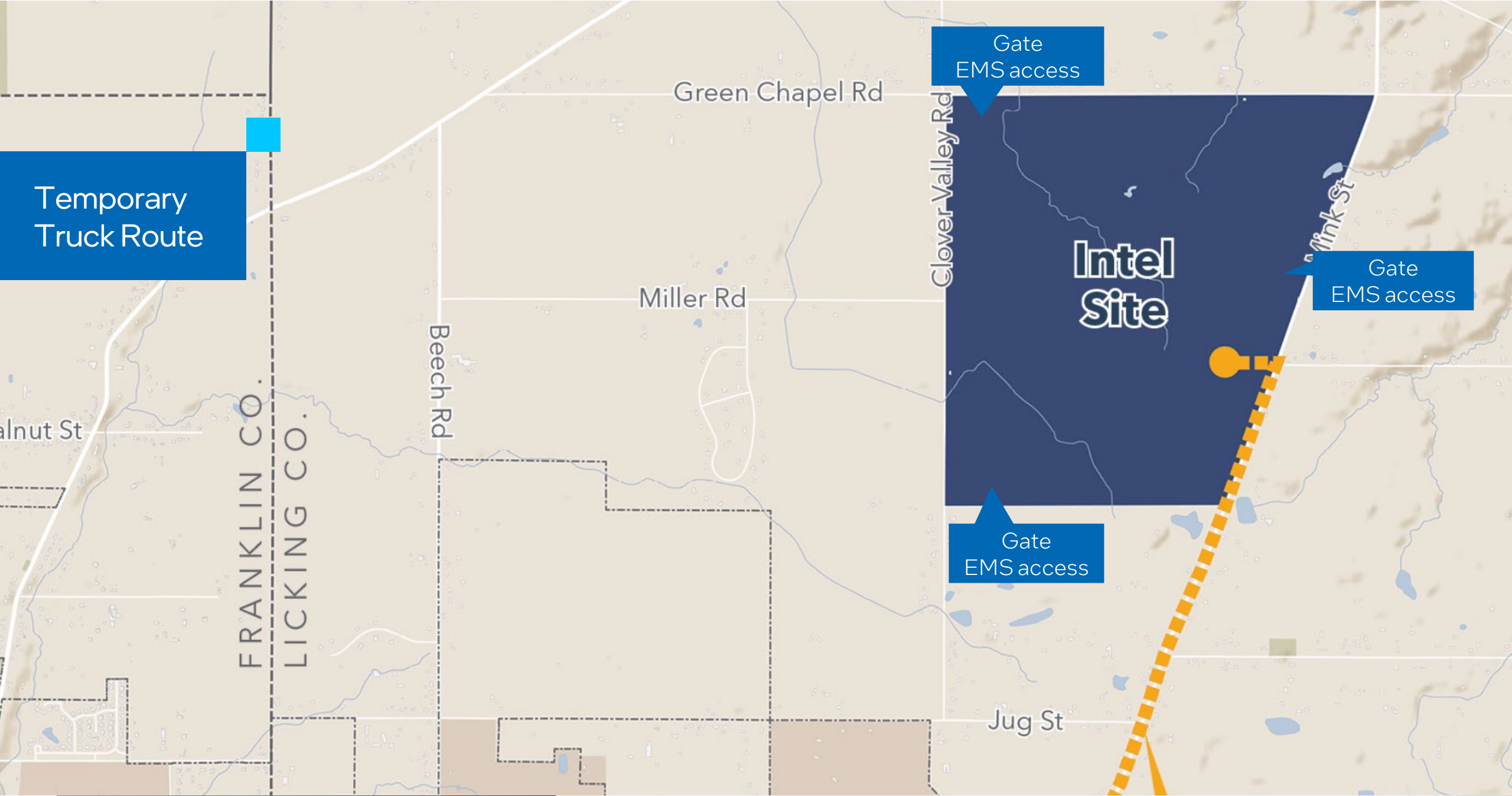

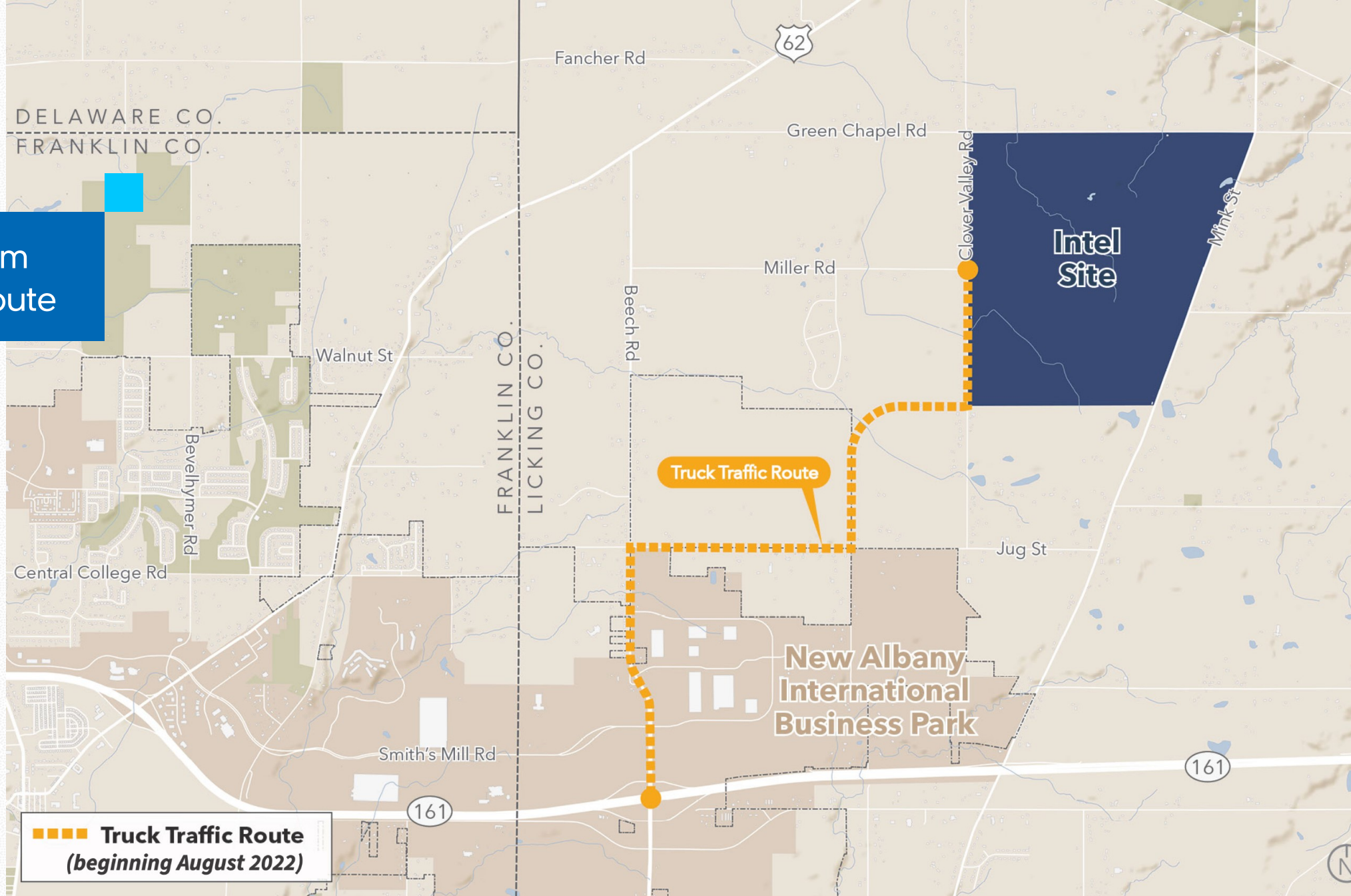

# Dust Mitigation Plan

- Daily street sweeping
- Daily water truck use where earth moving activities take place
- Truck wash stations located at each gate, used prior to leaving the site to remove mud and rocks during wet conditions
- Street vacuuming depending on daily conditions





# Dust Mitigation: Street Sweeping Equipment



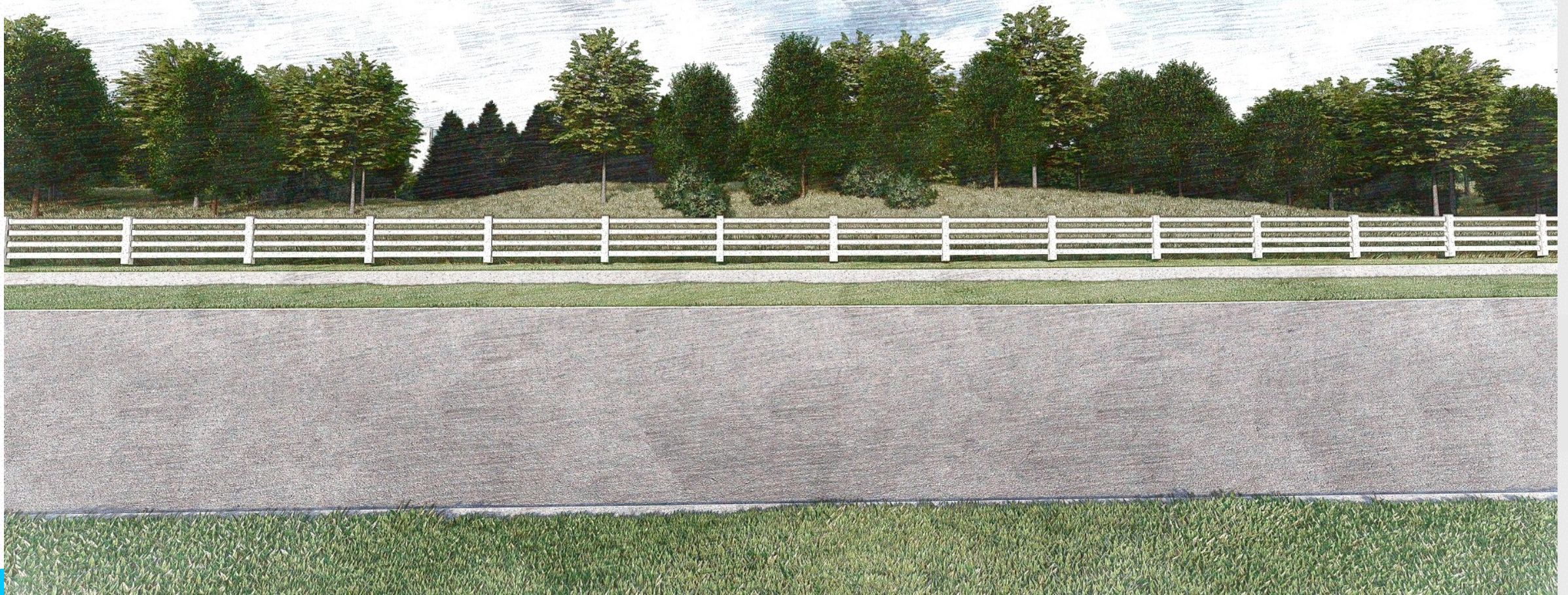


# Water

- Water for initial construction projects will temporarily be drawn from the ground until early 2023 when ongoing operations will be supported by city water.
- No impacts to landowner wells are expected.
