#### Police Week

The department celebrated National Police Week this month from May 9th– May 15th, which recognizes officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty while serving their community. The department would like to thank those who took the time to honor our officers this week. Mayor Spalding delivered a proclamation at the May 17th City Council Meeting declaring Police Week and Peace Officer Memorial Day on May 15th in the City of New Albany.

As part of the Light Ohio Blue campaign, Detective Southers participated in the Light Ohio Blue cruiser caravan through Franklin County and Sergeant Nauman participated in the Licking County caravan. Many area agencies also participated and represented their departments.

Light Ohio Blue is a statewide campaign to show support to the law enforcement personnel who protect our communities throughout the state. It gives the opportunity to honor and pay respects to the law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty as well as those currently serving.





#### Founder's Day

New Albany Founder's Day was held on May 21st– despite the bad weather that cut the event short, the event was still successful. Officers led the parade and worked to direct traffic and provide security during the event. The department also provided Child ID cards to families in attendance.

#### <u>Honor Ride</u>

Project Hero's annual Honor Ride through New Albany was held over Memorial Day weekend. The Honor Ride is "non-competitive cycling event where active service members, injured veterans, first responders and the general public all get to rider together". The department assisted riders through various city intersections and the event was successful.



#### **DARE Graduation**

352 fifth grade students graduated from the Drug Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E) program on May 16th at the McCoy Center. Officer Jobie Warner led this year's class, teaching student to make good decisions, resist peer pressure and live productive drug and violence free lives. Officer Kelly, K-9 Amigo and his handler, Officer Rehnert joined the celebration to congratulate the students on a great job.



#### **SIDNE**

The department's Simulated Impaired Driving Experience (SIDNE) was deployed at the high school this month. The SIDNE cart gives students the opportunity to experience operating a vehicle while simulating the effects of impairment. This allows students to have first-hand experience of the dangers of impaired driving. This was particularly important as this was the week of the junior/senior prom for the high school students.





#### New Detective

Officer Chad Bauman was selected as the department's next detective. With the retirement of Officer Wall, the detective position became vacant. Officer Bauman is an outstanding patrol officer who has demonstrated a consistent and balanced work ethic and has been involved in several investigations and operations. He will begin his training next month.

#### **Retirement**

Officer Jeff Wall retired this month after 27 years of service to the City of New Albany. Officer Wall joined the department in 1994 and has served as a patrol officer, detective, property room custodian and drone pilot. He played an integral role in developing the detective position and served as the department's only detective for much of his career. #### New Sergeant Swear In

Officer Oren Nauman was sworn in as the department's sixth sergeant this month. He has been in law enforcement for over seven years and during his time with the New Albany Police Department, he has served as a firearms instructor, drone pilot, field training officer and armorer. Nauman will serve as a third shift patrol sergeant along with Sergeant Deckop after completing his field training with the current sergeants.




#### K9 Amigo Deployment Summary

During the month of May, Amigo and his handler conducted 15 detection deployments with 10 indications, resulting in the seizure of over 30 items.

Amigo and Officer Rehnert also participated in the Founder's Day Parade and in the D.A.R.E graduation ceremony. During the D.A.R.E graduation, the K9 team provided a drug detection demonstration for the students and explained how Amigo helps keep our community safe.
