Commendation

New Albany City Council recognized New Albany Police Sergeant Garrett Fernander, Officer Nate Ferguson and Officer Joe Rehnert with Certificates of Commendation at the March 21st council meeting. The officers responded to the report of a suicidal man with a gun. While holding the gun, he approached the officers and fired a round into the dirt. The officers took cover and attempted to de-escalate the situation. Officers took advantage of the less-lethal option of bean bag rounds and were able to take him into custody and transport him to treatment.

The officers displayed courage, excellent judgment and sound tactics to protect themselves, others and the individual in safely bringing an end to a potentially deadly situation. The responding officers are commended for their bravery, sound decision making and commitment to the department's mission and values.



ALICE/Active Shooter Trainings

Officer Catanese and Officer Warner gave a presentation on active threat issues and a mini ALICE active shooter response training. ALICE stands for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate. This training

K9 Amigo Deployment Summary

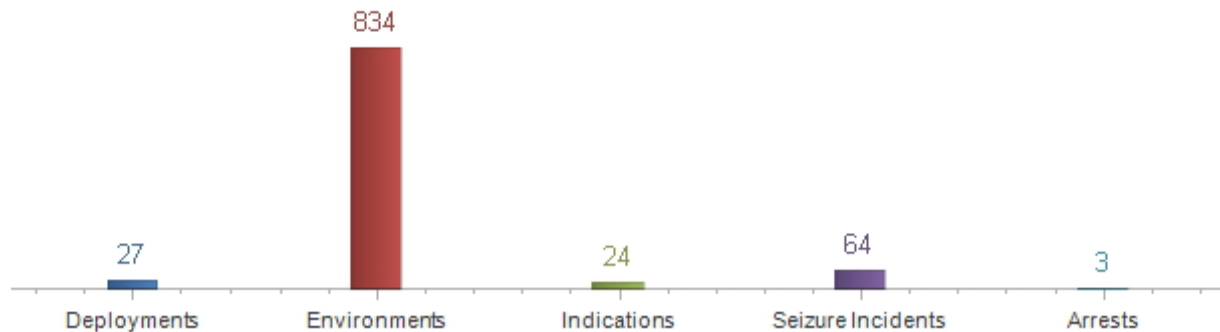
During the month of March, Amigo and his handler conducted 27 detection deployments with 24 indications, resulting in the seizure of over 60 items and three arrests.

A K9 sweep was conducted at the New Albany Plain Local High School this month. Several agencies participated in a large area sweep to include multiple student and staff parking areas and randomly selected classrooms and lockers inside the school.



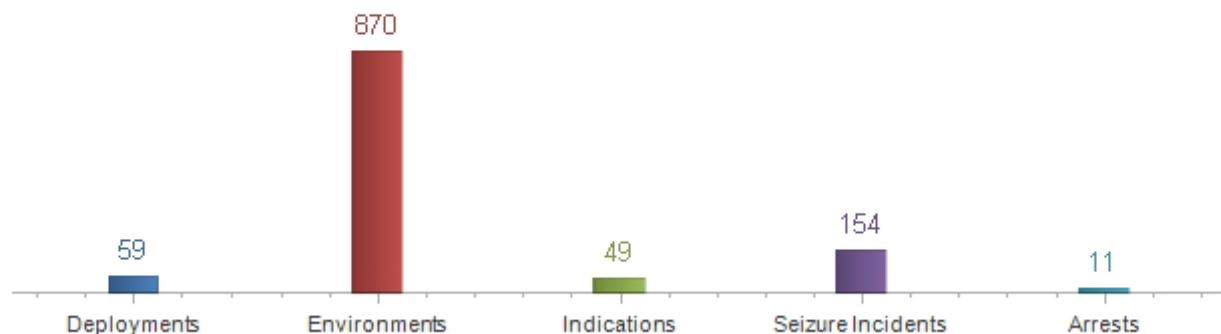
