Drug Take Back Day

Officer Kelly and Officer Mills participated in the Drug Enforcement Agency's (DEA) Drug Take Back Initiative in partnership with Plain Township Fire Department. This offers the opportunity for citizens to turn in unwanted medications for destruction. The officers operated a site at the Plain Township Fire Department and collected 69 pounds of unwanted medication that may have historically been abused by others or disposed of in harmful ways such as in the City's water supply.

DARE Graduation

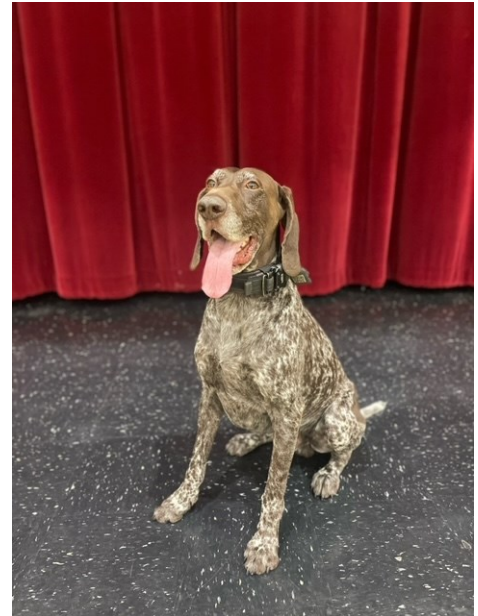

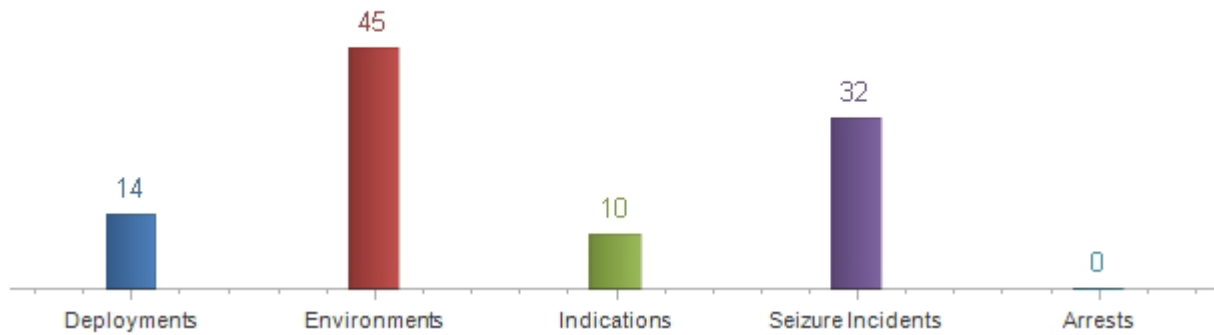
K9 Amigo Deployment Summary

During the month of April, Amigo and his handler conducted 14 detection deployments with 10 indications, resulting in the seizure of over 40 items.



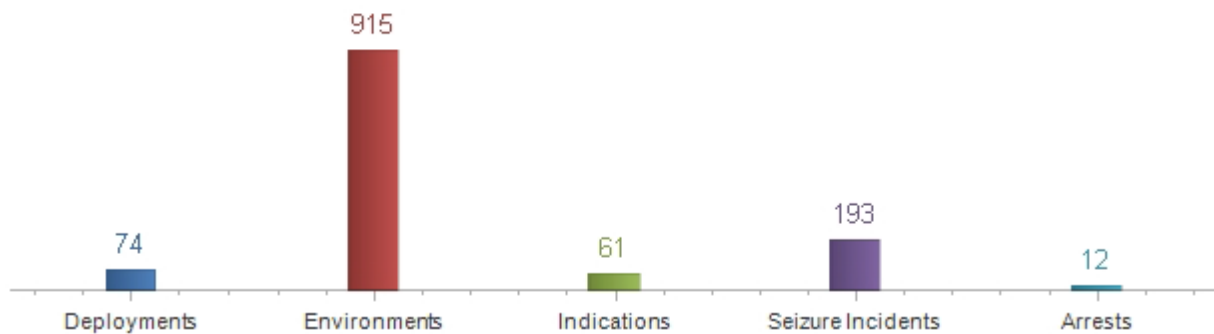
