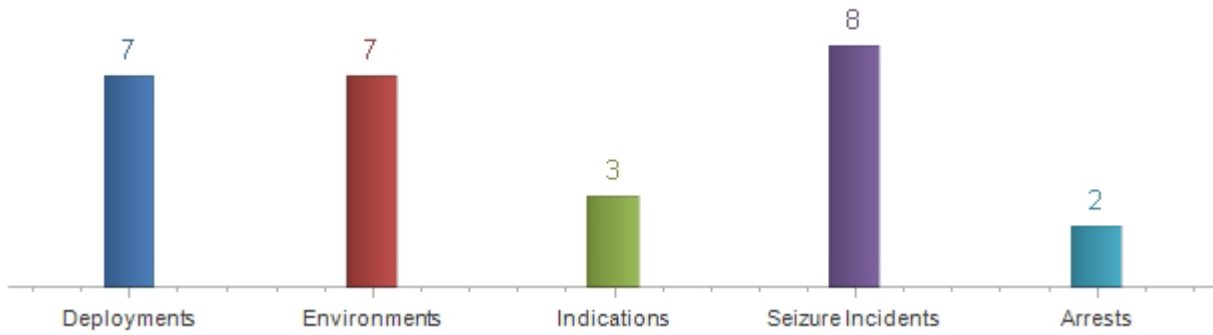
K9 Amigo Deployment Summary

During the month of February, Amigo and his handler conducted seven detection deployments with three indications, resulting in the seizure of eight items and two arrests.



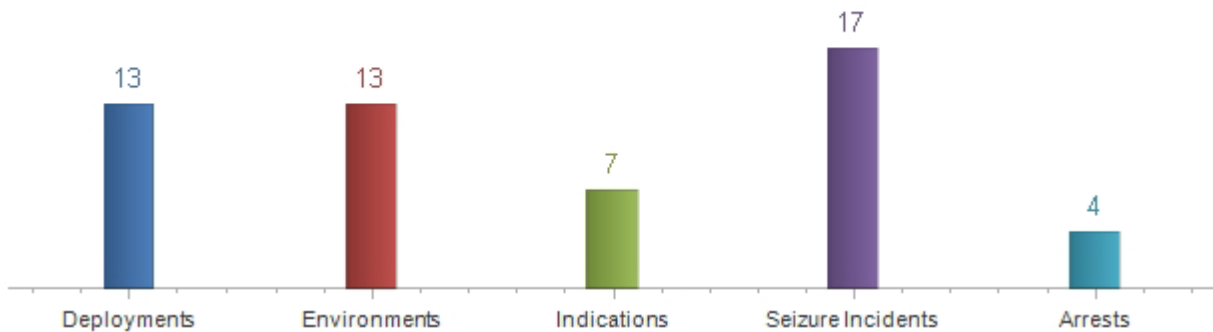
