

MEMORIAL TREE PROGRAM APPLICATION FORM

The city of New Albany's memorial tree program allows families and friends to leave a lasting, living memorial or recognition to loved ones in the form of a tree and plaque. The program provides residents an opportunity to recognize important occasions such as anniversaries, weddings, births and retirements; as well as to memorialize the loss of a loved one.

WHERE CAN A TREE BE PLANTED?

Trees are planted within city of New Albany parks. The city staff will work with those purchasing the tree to determine an appropriate location and species type.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The fee of \$1,495 purchases a 1.5-2-inch caliper deciduous tree or a 6-8-foot evergreen. The Tree also comes with a 9x6 inch bronze plaque with an inscription of your choice. The city of New Albany will plant, mulch, water and prune the tree as necessary.
