DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS June 2024

Safety Town

This year, Safety Town camp hosted over 300 children within the three programs; Safety Town, Graduate Camp and First Grade Camp. Campers had the opportunity to practice pedestrian and bike safety at the Adventureland site, water safety at the Plain Local Aquatic Center and animal safety. They also took a tour of the police and fire stations. Safety Town is taught by certified teachers, New Albany Police Officers, Plain Township Firefighters and assisted by volunteers.

We would like to thank New Albany City Council, the Safety Town sponsors, New Albany Plain Local School District, the New Albany Service Department and the Plain Township Fire Department for their assistance in making Safety Town's 20th year successful.









Commercial Vehicle Enforcement

This spring, the department sent two additional police officers to commercial vehicle enforcement training in response to the increase in truck traffic that the city is experiencing with the number of businesses and construction in the business campus. The training coincided with some complaints the city received about truck traffic. Recently, the department has also teamed up with the Ohio Highway Patrol and the Public Utilities Commission's Motor Carrier Enforcement to conduct enforcement blitzes and to focus on enforcement daily. Typical truck violations include missing mud flaps, speed, no driver's license, and multiple violations resulting in trucks being removed from the road. Officers and troopers have issued a significant number of citations and warnings, and commercial enforcement will remain a focus in the months to come.

DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS June 2024

Torch Run

The department hosted a local leg of the Law Enforcement Torch Run for Special Olympics Ohio on June 27th. The run kicks off the Special Olympics Ohio Summer Games as part of the Opening Ceremony and helps to raise awareness and funds for the Special Olympics. Members of the New Albany Police Department along with members of New Albany Special Olympics ran and carried the Flame of Hope from the New Albany Police Department to the New Albany High School stadium. The department raised over \$1,000 which contributed to the statewide effort that raised over \$99,000.



Community Policing

With summer in full swing, officers have many of opportunities to interact with the community while they are out on patrol or attending events.

- Officers have been handing out ice cream coupons as part of our bike helmet program.






DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS June 2024

During the month of June, Amigo and his handler conducted eight detection deployments with nine indications, resulting in the seizure of 25 items and two arrests.


