

A PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING RICHARD FISHER AS THE 2025 DR. GLYDE A MARSH NEW ALBANY FOUNDERS DAY PARADE GRAND MARSHAL

WHEREAS, Dick had a distinguished career in Clinton Township as a firefighter, fire chief, bureau chief, and part-time police officer; and

WHEREAS, Dick was a strong advocate for police and fire departments and participated in the first-ever New Albany Citizen's Police Academy; and

WHEREAS, Dick was a good man and a great citizen; he will be much missed by the community.
