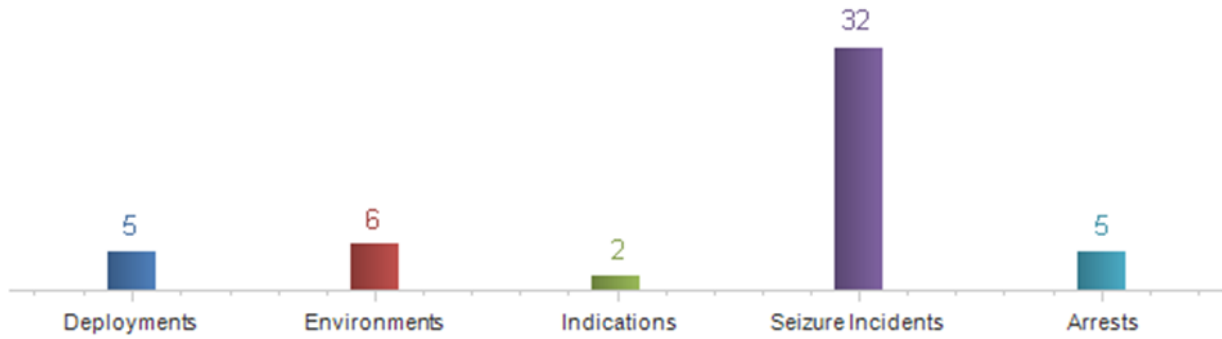
### K9 Amigo Deployment Summary

During the month of October, Amigo and his handler conducted five detection deployments with two indications and five arrests.



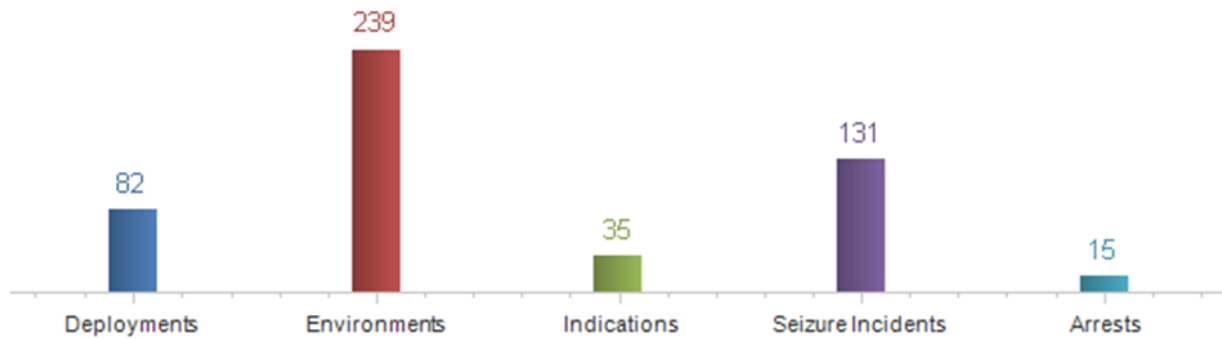

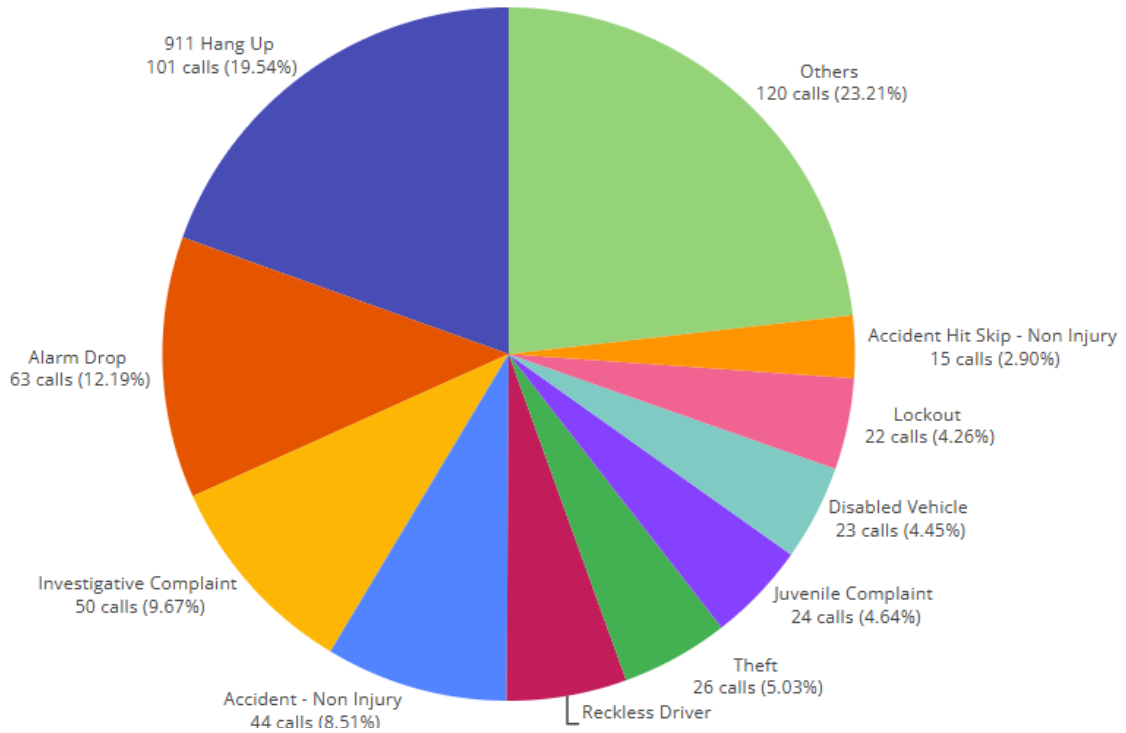

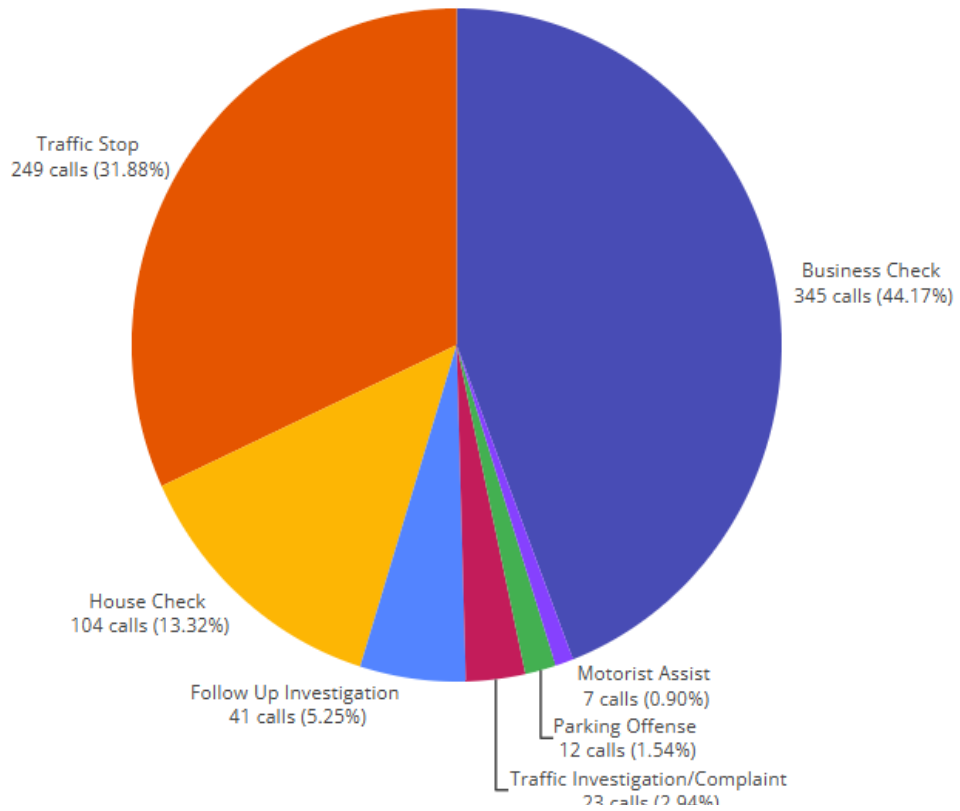

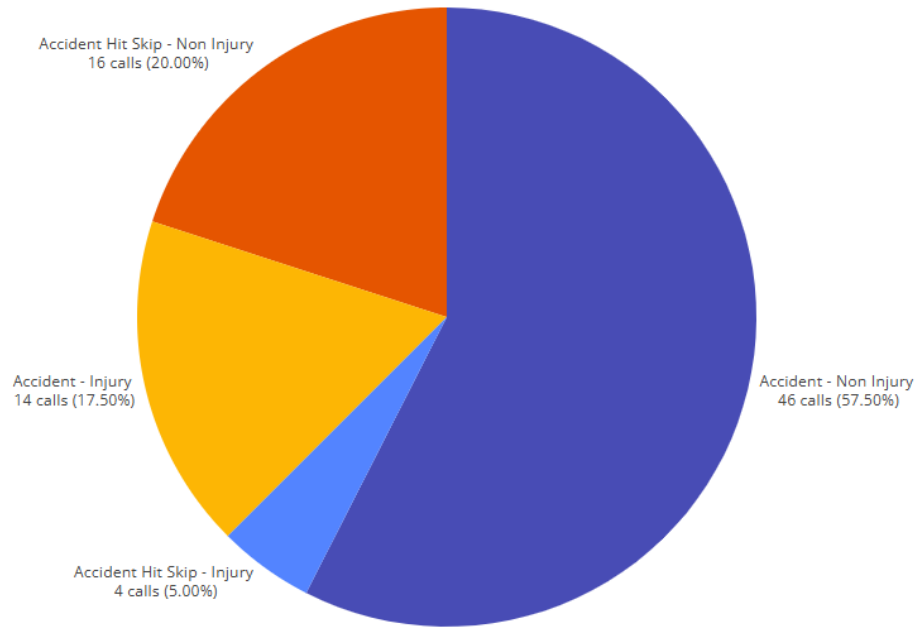

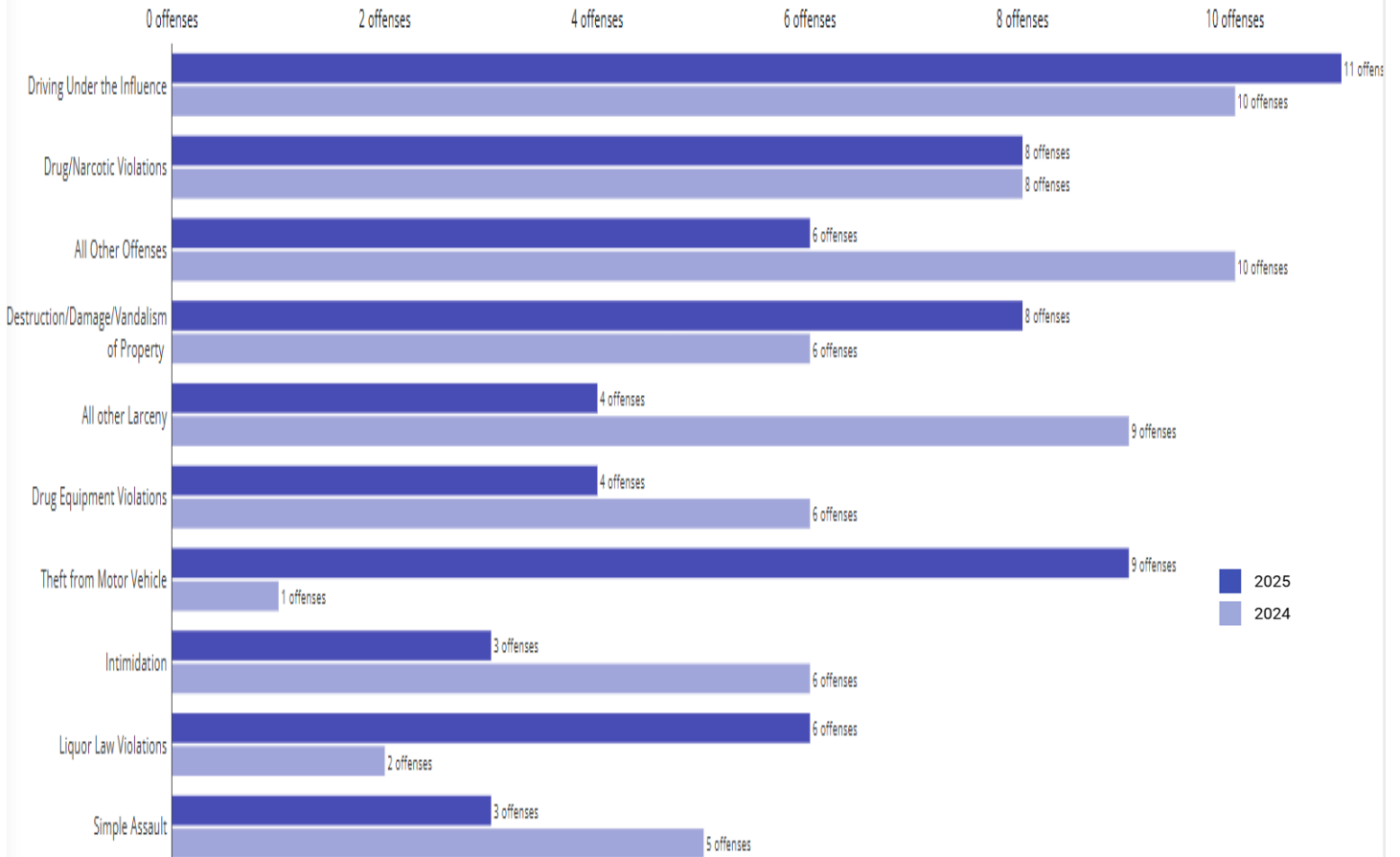

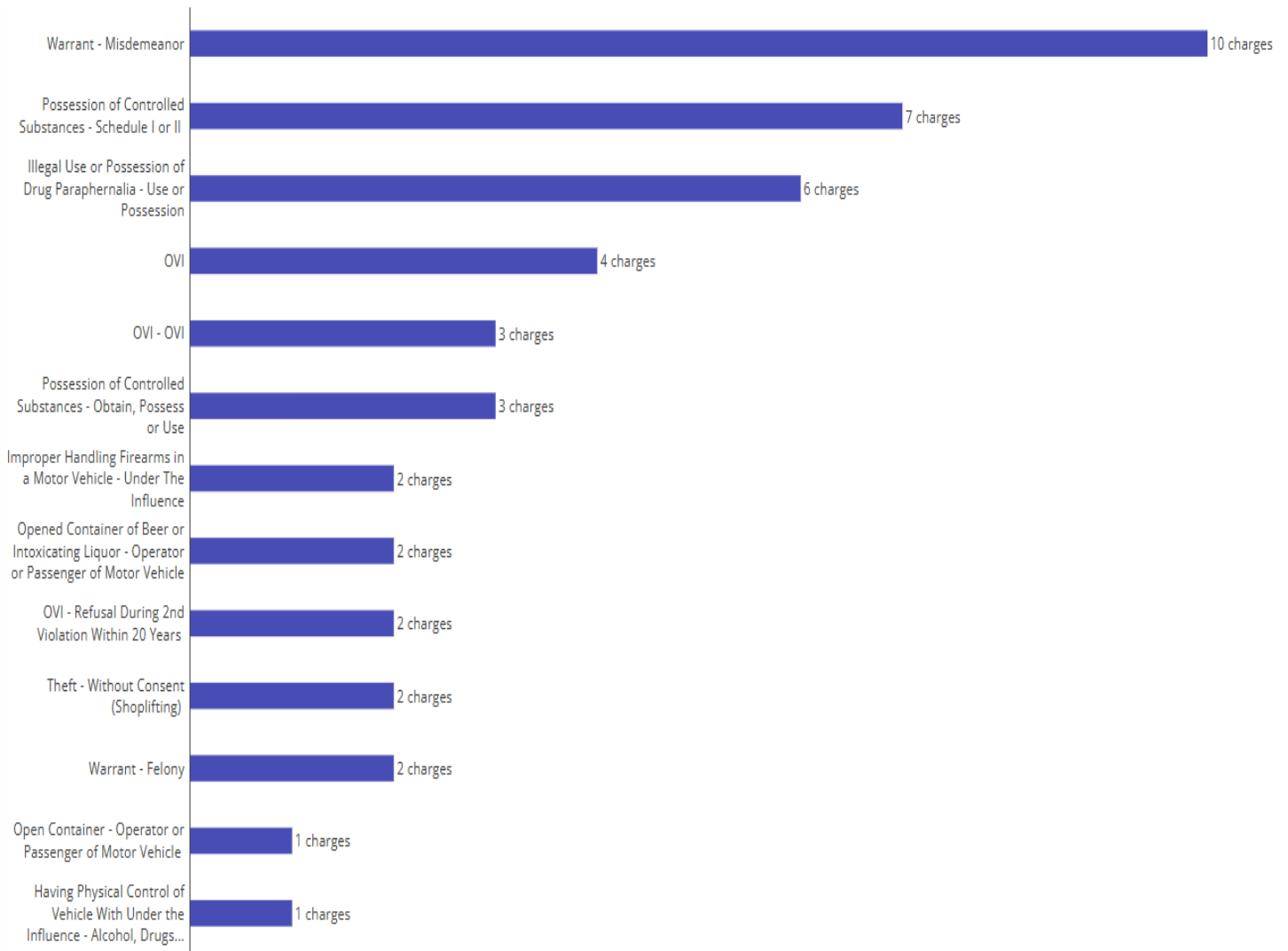
# ACCIDENT BY TYPE
