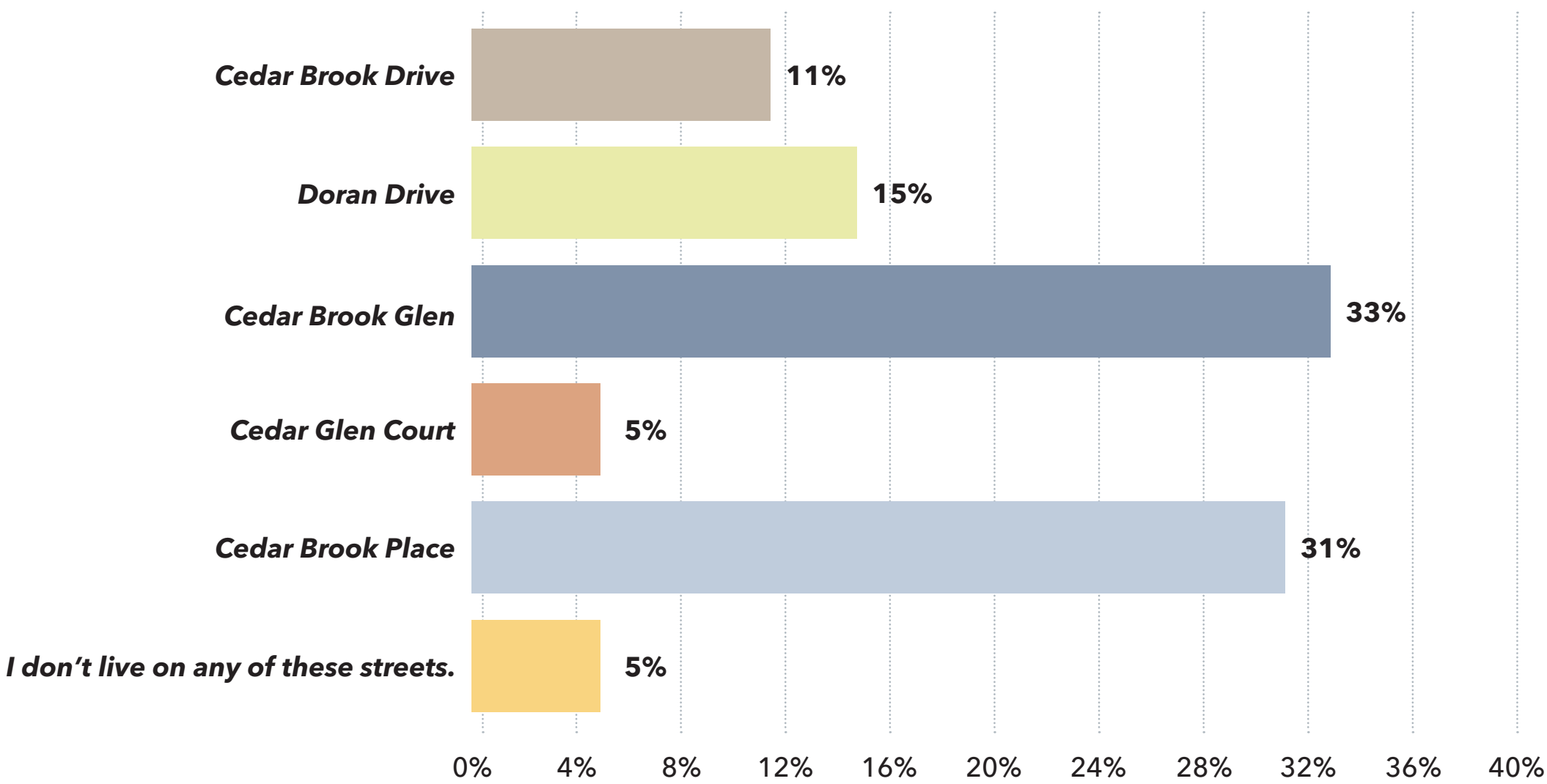


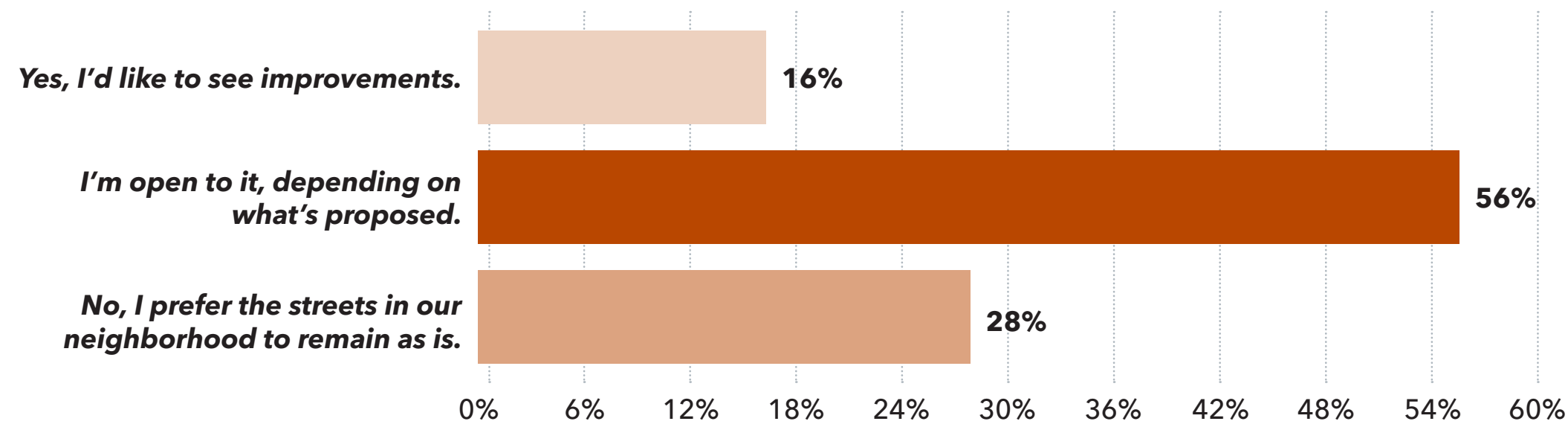
SURVEY RESULTS

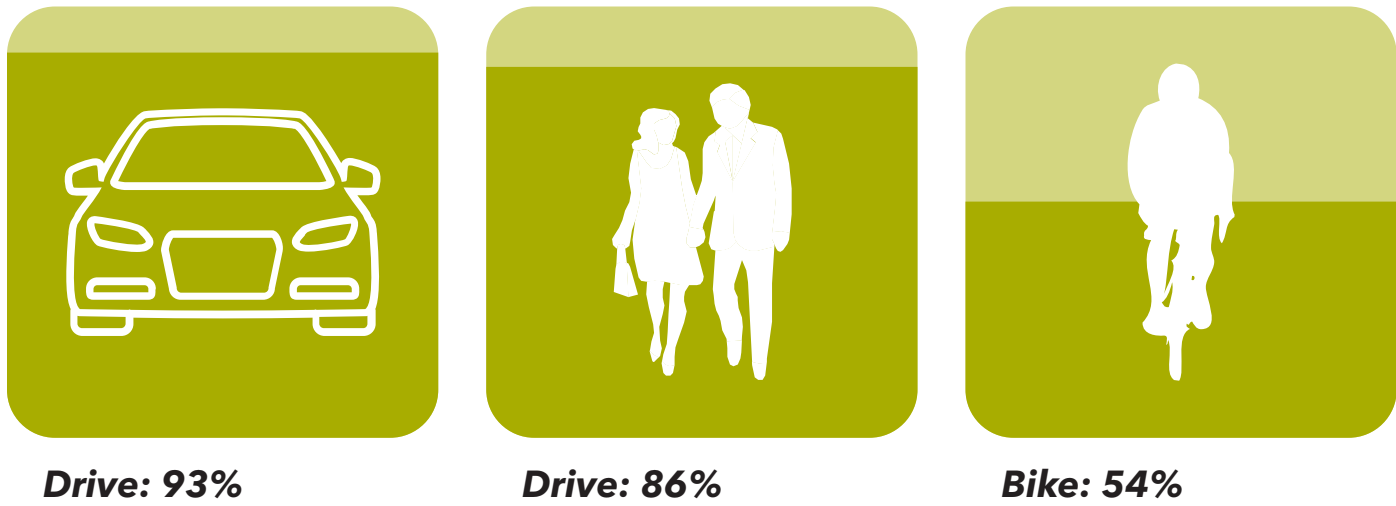
Which street in the Cedar Brook neighborhood do you live on? (n=61)



Are you interested in streetscape improvements in your neighborhood? (n=61)

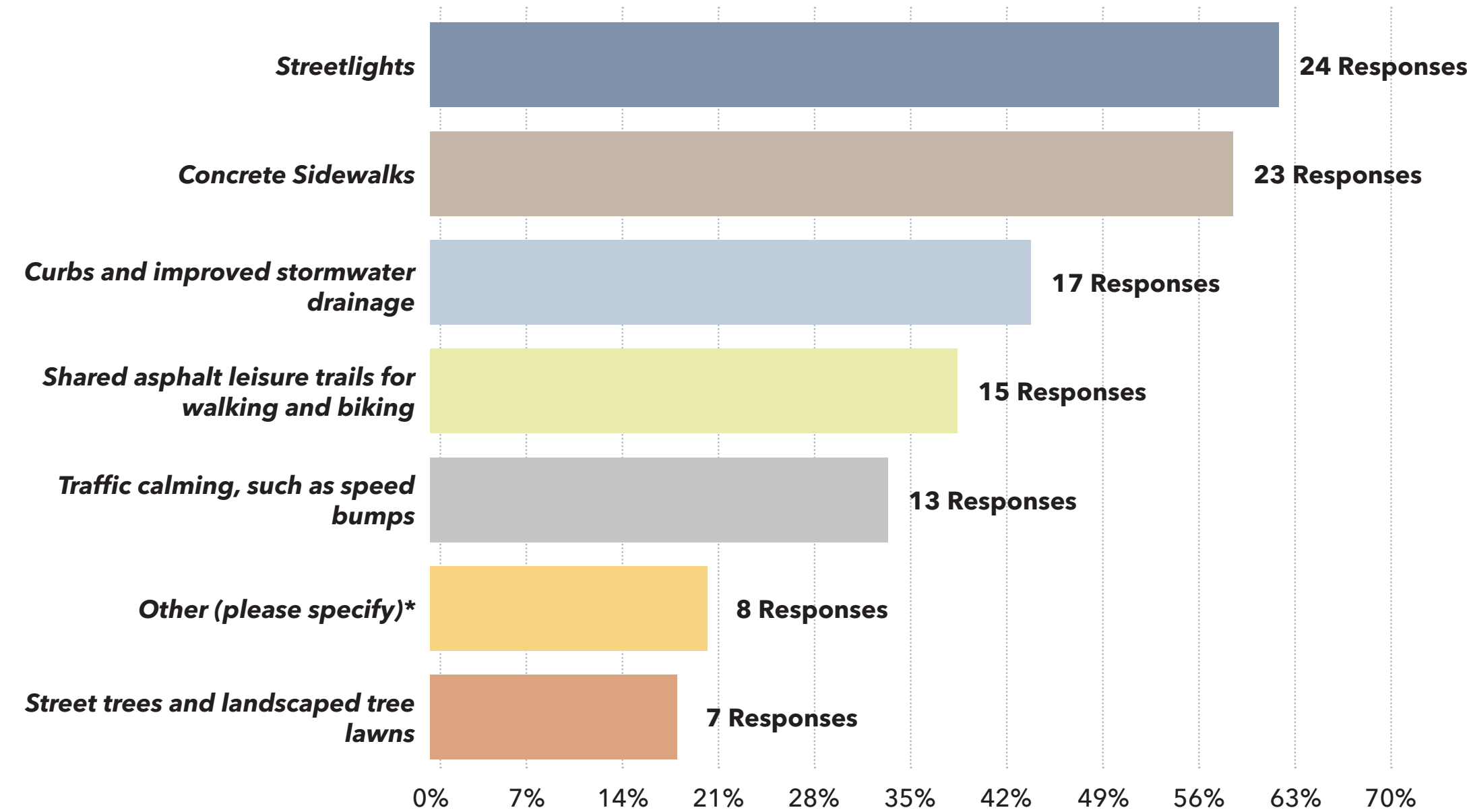


How do you currently get around your neighborhood? (n=57)



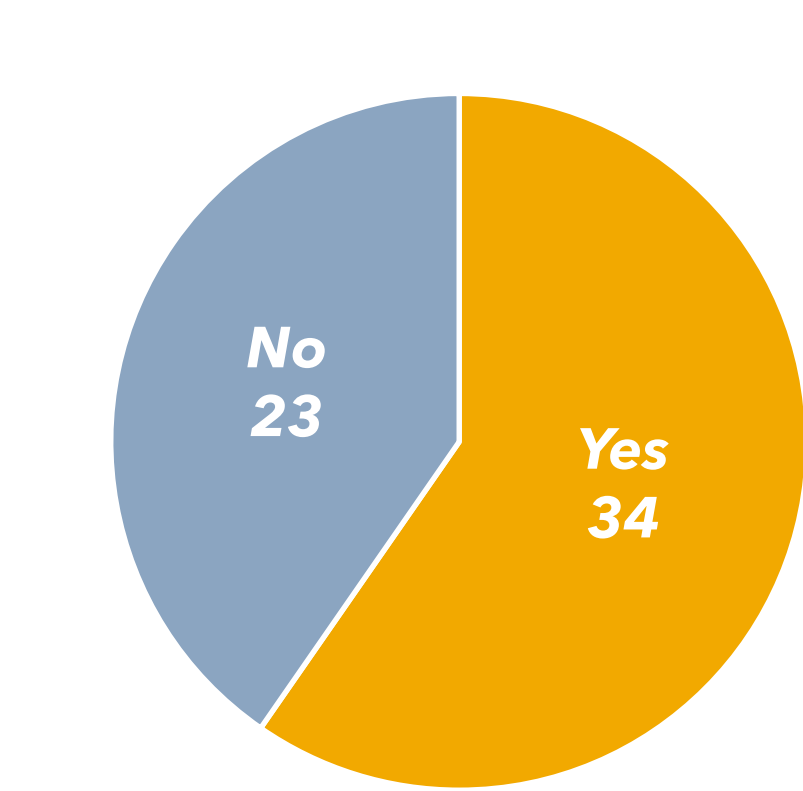
- Other responses:

 - lane markings & fog lines. New pavement as it is falling apart. Signage directing pedestrians which side of the road to be on and to yield a safe distance to vehicular traffic. See if you can do something about bicyclists & scooters running stop signs, and riding spread out across the entire 2 land road so that some of them are riding head on at you. Trees to be trimmed back away from the roadway. wider roadways. NO speed bumps - they are hard on vehicles and people with back or other health conditions.
